- Missing Games: email was sent to try and capture results from missing games
- General discussion about competition: would like to find more competitive balance among Gold, Silver, and Bronze and fortify some groupings (e.g. U12 and U15 Boys Gold). Discussed possibility of moving from single-age to dual-age within SECJSA in order to bolster roster sizes, keep school grades together, and create competitive balance. Idea to keep Gold and Silver competitive and market Bronze as rec level (and 9v9). Also discussed the option of creating a "Big Town" and "Small Town" division within each Gold and Silver grouping
- Spring season: Many of the topics mentioned above will be discussed in advance of the spring season. Meeting will take place on February 9th to discuss spring structure. A second meeting will take place (April) to enter teams/rosters for spring season.
